Safety Instructions

When using electrical products, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Check that the voltage indicated on the rating plate corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the product to the mains power supply.

Keep the product and its supply cord away from heat or sharp edges that could cause damage.

Keep the power supply cord away from any parts of the product that may become hot during use.

Keep hands, fingers, hair and any loose clothing away from the rotating tools of the product.

Do not immerse the product in water or any other liquid.

Do not operate the product with wet hands.

Do not leave the product unattended whilst connected to the mains power supply or when in use.

Do not remove the product from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch it off and remove the plug by hand.

Do not use the product for anything other than its intended use.

Do not use this product outdoors.

Do not move the product whilst it is in use.

Do not shake the product.

Do not cover the product.

Do not clean the product with abrasive chemicals or materials such as scourers, as they may damage the product.

Do not spray insecticide or chemical solvents on the product.

Always unplug the product after use and before any cleaning or maintenance.

Always use the product on a flat, stable surface.

Use of an extension cord with the product is not recommended.

This product should not be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system, other than that supplied with this product.

This product is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.

Warning: If a strong odour is emitted from the product, turn the unit off and unplug it from the mains power supply.


Care and Maintenance

Always wait until the pedestal fan has stopped completely and unplug it from the mains power supply before performing any cleaning or user maintenance.

Wipe the pedestal fan with a soft, damp, lint-free cloth and allow to dry thoroughly.

Do not immerse the pedestal fan in water or any other liquid. Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents, polishes or scouring pads to clean the pedestal fan, as this may cause damage.

Assembling the Pedestal Fan Assembling the Base

STEP 1: Attach the cross stand leg with the cut-out section on top of the other cross stand leg and firmly press down to secure them together.

STEP 2: Remove the four screws from the cross stand legs and then attach the adjustable base pole by aligning the stabiliser holes with the screw holes on the cross stand legs.

STEP 3: Insert the screws through each of the aligned holes and carefully tighten in a clockwise direction.

STEP 4: Slide the cross stand screw cover over the adjustable base pole, align the cutouts with the cross stand legs and push into position.

STEP 5: Remove the height adjustment cap by turning it in the anticlockwise direction and pulling away.

STEP 6: Replace the height adjustment cap, and turn in a clockwise direction until secure.

Attaching the Base to the Fan Head

STEP 1: Loosen the height adjustment cap by twisting it in an anticlockwise direction, then pull out the inner adjustable base pole.

STEP 2: When the adjustable base pole is at the desired height, tighten the height adjustment cap by twisting it in a clockwise direction to secure the adjustable base pole into position.

STEP 3: Release the fan head locking screw by turning it in an anticlockwise direction, then slot the pedestal fan head onto the adjustable base pole.

STEP 4: Carefully turn the fan head locking screw in a clockwise direction to lock the pedestal fan head into position.

Note: If the adjustable base pole cannot be fully inserted, loosen the fan head locking screw further.

Take care not to overtighten the height adjustment cap and fan head locking screw, as this may cause damage to the pedestal fan.

Assembling the Fan Head

STEP 1: Remove the rear grill locking nut from the motor assembly by twisting it in an anticlockwise direction.

STEP 2: Position the rear grill over the motor assembly shaft, checking that it is aligned with the two small plastic pins on the motor assembly and that the carry handle at the back of the rear grill is in an upright position. Secure the rear grill by replacing the rear grill locking nut and twisting it in a clockwise direction until secure.

STEP 3: Position the fan blade unit onto the motor assembly shaft, pushing it gently inwards. Add the blade locking cap; twist it in an anticlockwise direction until the fan blade unit is secured into position.

STEP 4: Open the clips around the outer edge of the front grill and position it onto the rear grill, so that the screw holes on both grills are aligned at the bottom. Fasten the clips around the outer edge of the front grill to lock the grills into position.

STEP 5: Insert the front grill screw through the hole at the bottom of the front and rear grills, then place the nut onto the grill screw and tighten it in a clockwise direction to hold the grills together.

Caution: Take care not to overtighten the rear grill locking nut or the blade locking cap.

Instructions for Use

Before connecting to the mains power supply, place the assembled pedestal fan onto a flat, stable surface, allowing for sufficient distance between the pedestal fan and any objects that could get damaged or caught in the rotating fan blades.

Note: This is not a desk fan. Do not place the fan on a desk as this could affect the stability of the product.

Do not cover the fan head.

Using the 16 Inch Pedestal Fan

STEP 1: Plug in and switch on the pedestal fan at the mains power supply.

STEP 2: To turn on the pedestal fan, select the desired cooling speed (1-3) on the control panel. Setting '3' is the strongest cooling speed setting.

STEP 3: Activate the oscillation function by pressing the oscillation switch down. To stop the pedestal fan from oscillating, pull the oscillation switch up.

Tilting the Fan Head

STEP 1: Loosen the tilting head screw by turning it in an anticlockwise direction.

STEP 2: Position the fan head at the desired angle.

STEP 3: Tighten the tilting head screw by turning it in a clockwise direction until secure.

Adjusting the Fan Height

STEP 1: Loosen the height adjustment cap by twisting it in an anticlockwise direction.

STEP 2: Pull out the inner pole from the adjustable base pole until the fan is at the desired height.

STEP 3: Twist the height adjustment cap in a clockwise direction until secure.

Note: Take care not to overtighten the height adjustment cap.

As the colours in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, please proceed as follows:


The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

Blue Neutral (N)

Brown Live (L)

Green/Yellow Earth (<u>↓</u>)

FOR UK USE ONLY - Plug fitting details (where applicable).



The wire coloured BLUE is the NEUTRAL and must be connected to the terminal marked N or coloured BLACK.

The wire coloured BROWN is the LIVE wire and must be connected to the terminal marked L or coloured RED.

The wire coloured GREEN/YELLOW must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter E or marked \perp .

On no account must either the BROWN or the BLUE wire be connected to the EARTH terminal ($\frac{1}{2}$).

Always ensure that the cord grip is fastened correctly.

The plug must be fitted with a fuse of the same rating already fitted and conforming to BS 1362 and be ASTA approved.

If in doubt consult a qualified electrician who will be pleased to do this for you.

Non-rewireable mains plug

If your appliance is supplied with a non-rewireable plug fitted to the mains lead and should the fuse need replacing, you must use an ASTA approved one (conforming to BS 1362 of the same rating).

If in doubt, consult a qualified electrician who will be pleased to do this for you. If you need to remove the plug - DISCONNECT IT FROM THE MAINS and then cut it off the mains lead and immediately dispose of it safely. Never attempt to reuse the plug or insert it into a socket outlet as there is a danger of an electric shock.
